<p>REMARKS: The objective of this trip is to earn the coveted Snow Sports Merit Badge. We will meet at Scout Hall at 5:30 PM (please be on time). It will take about 3.5 hours to get to the hotel with a stop in transit for supper. We should arrive at Creekside Lodge around 10:30 PM. Next morning, we will have a Continental Breakfast at 7:00 AM, and be at Cataloochee Ski Area at 8:00 AM for gear and lift tickets. Lessons (deductible from the estimated price above) are mandatory for beginners and encouraged for all others. The mountain opens at 8:30 AM for skiing. Will have lunch at Cataloochee Lodge. Each Scout will be given \$10.00 cash each day for lunch. Adults will provide all their own meals except Saturday dinner. The mountain closes at 4:30 PM when we will return to Creekside Lodge. We will have a salad and pizza supper at Garlic Knots Restaurant. On Sunday we get up, check out, and do it all over again. We will leave from Cataloochee Ski Area by 5:00 PM, stop on the road for supper, and return to Scout Hall at approximately 9:30 PM.</p> <p>Scouts and parents should look at the Cataloochee website, www.cataloochee.com. Scouts may choose either skiing, or snowboarding. Fill out page 2 carefully and completely. The mountain has 740 feet of vertical drop on the runs, and the top of the mountain is over 5,400'. The longest run is 3,500'. They have Expert, Intermediate and Novice slopes. Cataloochee has been in operation 40+ years. If the temperature is below freezing, there will be plenty of snow, since they make their own on the slopes. We will discuss proper clothing at a meeting at Scout Hall prior to the trip. Helmets are mandatory so bring one or be prepared to rent one. (\$5.00/day.) You can rent a ski bib and jacket for \$16.00/day if you do not have them. NOTE – WEAR CLASS B for travel, NOT CLASS A.</p> <p>DIRECTIONS: Take I-85 North to I-985. Take I-985 to U.S. 23 exiting in the city of Waynesville (exit 102B). Take 276 North to U.S. 19 South (turn left) and follow the signs.
